CHILD-RESPONDENT'S ANSWER TO TRUANT CONDUCT

I, _____, Child-Respondent, have reviewed the petition alleging that I engaged in truant conduct under Chapter 65 of the Family Code. After being informed of the allegations against me, the nature and possible consequences of the proceedings, my privilege against self-incrimination, my right to trial and to confront witnesses against me, my right to representation by an attorney, and my right to a jury trial, I appear and file my answer of (check one):
